

Geography Department

The Geography department is a successful department which consistently achieves good results across all key stages.

It has four Geography specialists and is very popular at A level and GCSE.

Geography is taught to all students in Years 7 and 8. In Years 9, 10 and 11 it is taught as an option, following the AQA GCSE course. Usually there are four or five groups in each of the GCSE years. There are seven groups in each year of key stage three. Fieldwork in the form of geographical enquiries is an integral part of this course.

At A-level we teach the AQA Geography Course. Integral to this course is a range of fieldwork exercises which includes residential fieldwork.

The department has a range of specialist classrooms, including breakout areas and good access to ICT facilities. It has an appropriate range of visual aids and storage facilities.

The successful candidate will be expected to teach across all key stages, including A Level, and contribute to the development of the Geography curriculum.

An ability to participate in the development of fieldwork (including trips out of school) will be required. A keen interest in ICT and its use in Geography would be an advantage.

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
