We offer a full two-year course in Theology that compromises of three distinct components:

1. H573/01: Philosophy of Religion

- Exam: 2hrs (x3 essays) = 33.3% of overall grade

2. H573/02: Religious Ethics

- Exam: 2hrs (x3 essays) = 33.3% of overall grade

3. H573/03: Developments in Christian Thought

- Exam: 2hrs (x3 essays) = 33.3% of overall grade
