PHYSICAL EDUCATION KIT

White polo shirt with school badge (Price and Buckland) This is the only polo shirt students should wear for PE lessons

Sports micro fleece with school badge- Compulsory for girls (Price and Buckland)

As some PE lessons take place outside, it is essential that students have appropriate clothing for all weather conditions. The micro fleece is lightweight and allows a good range of movement for PE

School rugby top- Compulsory for boys (Price and Buckland) As some PE lessons take place outside it is essential that students have appropriate clothing for all weather conditions. The rugby top is a heavy duty top designed for contact activities

Shadow stripe navy blue school shorts (Price and Buckland/ High Street shops) Shorts should be navy in colour. Large or conspicuous logos are not allowed

School tracksuit bottoms- optional(Price and Buckland/ High Street shops) Tracksuit bottoms should be navy in colour. Large brand logos are not permitted

Sky blue school socks (Price and Buckland/ High Street shops)

Non-marking indoor trainers

Trainers should be white in colour and be non-marking. The majority of black soled trainers are not non-marking; they will have non-marking logo on the sole if they are appropriate. Trainers should provide support to the ankle and foot **Outdoor trainers**

Trainers must be suitable for outdoor use. They should provide support to the ankle and foot

Football/ rugby boots- Compulsory for boys

Football boots are required for invasion games on grass. Plastic or metal studs are acceptable

OTHER ITEMS

Socks and tights (for girls wearing skirts)

Socks should be plain, grey or black and knee length. Socks should not be worn above the knee. Tights should 40 denier and they should be black or grey in colour

School bag

Every pupil should have a bag large enough and sturdy enough to carry all their books and other equipment. A rucksack or a bag with a shoulder strap is ideal. Bags should be plain and dark in colour. Bags with logos or obvious branding are not allowed

Jewellery

Due to health and safety issues jewellery should not be worn with the exception of a wrist watch, one pair of stud earrings and medical bracelets. Any other jewellery will be confiscated. Any kind of piercing (other than one in each ear) is not allowed; if necessary pupils will be sent home until this issue is resolved. If your child has their ears pierced they will be asked to remove their earrings for PE lessons

Make-up

Make-up should be kept to an absolute minimum. If make-up is obvious then it is not acceptable. False eyelashes are not allowed

Nails

Nail varnish is not allowed. Nail extensions are not allowed; if necessary pupils will be sent home until this issue is resolved

Tattoos

Tattoos are not allowed

Fashion Accessories

Pupils will be asked to remove any accessory which does not comply with our school uniform policy

Hair

The school reserves the right to insist that what we consider to be extreme hairstyling and/or colouring be changed. Hair should look natural in colour and style. If in doubt, please contact a senior member of staff before making any changes
