## Dear Parent/Carer

I write to you at the end of our first week back to school and for what has been, for the vast majority of our students, a long awaited return to school after almost six months of school closure. First and foremost I want to thank you for your support of the school, enabling a safe, positive and successful reintegration of our whole school community here at All Saints.
