Half Term 1

- Introduction session improvisation, teamwork, team building activities. Stage Combat.
 Practitioner Workshops: Frantic Assembly, Steven Berkoff, Konstantin Stanislavski,
 Antonin Artaud, Complicitie, DV8. Choice of Practitioner introduction to Devising stimulus extract. Equus practical exploration.
- Theory: Equus reading of (own time and some in class. Section B responses. Role of Designer and Role of Actor. Subject Specific Vocabulary focus, Breaking down of question and response.

Half Term 2

- Practical: Devising process begins. Log sheets to be completed after each session. Initial task: Montage; freeze frames, transitions; theme choices, creation of sections using specific Practitioner techniques. Vision / Aims and Intentions.
