Parent Governor Election

As indicated on the ballot paper you should vote by marking an 'X' alongside the name of the parent you support. Once you have marked the ballot paper you should seal it in an envelope, marked 'Election'.

This should then be returned either by your child and placed in the ballot box on reception or by post to the Governance Professional by 3pm on Wednesday 18 December 2024:
