We would like to invite you to a parent information meeting at **6pm on Wednesday 19 March**. Refreshments will be provided. Due to the limited space in the hall, we ask that only parents attend where possible. Parking around the site is limited so please plan this into your journey.

This year we are pleased to offer two Transition Days for all pupils. The dates for these are **Wednesday 25 June and Thursday 26 June.** All pupils are invited to attend both days. Further detailed information about these Transition Days will be sent in the summer term. A parents' drop-in session will be held at All Saints straight after school finishes on Thursday 26 June. At this time, you will be able to view and order school uniform and speak to members of staff.

As your child attends a feeder primary school, we are also inviting them to an afternoon with us at All Saints in April. This will be an opportunity for pupils from schools across the diocese to spend time together taking part in fun activities. Further information about this will come via primary schools.
