Introduction

At All Saints we are proud of our school uniform. Our uniform reflects our aspirational values for our students, and it is an integral part of the All Saints Way.

Wearing our uniform:

- builds pride in being a member of the All Saints family
- promotes a sense of community and belonging
- is practical, professional and smart
- ensures that all students feel equal to their peers in terms of appearance
- ensures that our students are easily recognisable as members of our school community.



Our students should wear their uniform with pride. We do not expect students to come to school wearing any items which do not comply fully with the uniform expectations detailed in this policy. If a student arrives at school without an item of uniform for whatever reason, they will be provided with a loan item from our uniform room which they will be expected to wear until the issue is resolved.

We ask parents/carers to support us by sending your child to school correctly dressed and equipped. This ensures that every minute of the school day can be used productively by both students and staff, in the pursuit of excellence for all. We aim to ensure that our uniform is cost effective and affordable to minimise the cost of purchasing uniform for our families.

We require all our students to comply with our uniform expectations. We understand that sometimes, there may be circumstances which mean that your child cannot come to school in perfect uniform. In such cases we will provide your child with a loan item from our uniform room until you are able to rectify the issue. If you have any difficulties or concerns about being able to do so, then please do contact your child's Year Leader who will be happy to work with you in order to find a solution.

For some students with additional needs, for example, sensory disorder, we understand there may need to be reasonable adjustments to uniform for these students. We will work with these students and their families to develop pre-agreed adjustments to uniform to meet their needs.

High street shops sell a variety of items in their 'school uniform' sections. Just because an item is sold as uniform it does not mean that it is an acceptable part of All Saints' uniform. Please refer to this policy and, if in doubt, check with school before making a purchase.

Compulsory Uniform

These items can be purchased from our uniform supplier [Price and Buckland](#) or from high street shops.



Plain Navy Blue Blazer

The school blazer is plain navy blue without any emblem or school badge.

It should be worn at all times and cannot be replaced by an outdoor coat.



Pale Blue Shirt

Shirts should have a proper collar designed for a tie. Shirts need to be worn with the top button fastened and should be tucked in at all times.

Shirts should not be fitted shirts.



Grey Tailored Trousers (not black)

Trousers should be made of plain grey material and tailored like suit trousers. The colour should be mid grey to dark grey, not light.

Jeans, leggings or any other type of casual trousers made of stretchy material are not allowed as these are too tight fitting.

Trousers should be worn at the waist and not below.

OR



Grey Skirt (not black)

Skirts should be plain grey, either mid or dark grey but not light. They can be straight, A-line or pleated and should be knee length or just above knee length.

Skirts made of stretchy material are not allowed as they are too tight fitting.

Socks and Tights (when wearing skirts)

Socks should be plain grey or black and knee length. Socks should not be worn above the knee. Tights should 40 denier and they should be black or grey in colour.



Plain Black Shoes

School shoes:

- must be fully black school shoes which are flat.
- must be fastened with a strap/laces.
- must be wipeable and suitable for all weathers.



School Bag

Every student should have a bag large enough and sturdy enough to carry all their books and other equipment. A rucksack or a bag with a shoulder strap is ideal.



Equipment

Students should be equipped with everything they may need during the school day. As a minimum, students should have the following items.

A pencil case containing:

- black or blue pen
- red pen
- pencil
- ruler
- scientific calculator

These items can only be purchased from school.



School Tie

The tie should be worn with the school badge showing and be correctly fastened.



Lanyard

The lanyard needs to be worn around the neck throughout the school day.

The lanyard is provided by school. In the case of loss or damage replacements will be charged at £2.50 via ParentPay.

School Shoe Expectations

The following examples are **suitable** for school:

- Fully black school shoe which must be flat.
- Shoes must be fastened with a strap/laces.
- Full shoe must be wipeable and suitable for all weathers.



The following examples are **NOT** allowed for school:

- No sports trainers, boots, or plimsolls.
- Shoes must not be suede, canvas, mesh or fabric.
- Shoes must not have logos in other colours.



Uniform Standards	
Outdoor Coats	Coats should be warm and waterproof. Coats are not to be worn within the school buildings. Hoodies and tracksuit tops are not considered to be outdoor coats and should not be brought to school at all.
Headwear	Hats, caps or any other type of headwear cannot be worn in school. Students are permitted to wear religious headwear.
Jewellery	Due to health and safety issues jewellery must not be worn with the exception of: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • a wristwatch, • a small, single bracelet Students will be asked to remove any other jewellery.
Earrings	Students may wear a maximum of 2 small stud earrings per ear. Students will need to remove their earrings for PE lessons.
Nose Studs	Students are permitted to wear a small, discrete nose stud that sits on the surface of the nose. Students are not permitted to wear nose rings or large nose studs as these are not part of our uniform policy. Students that wear nose rings or large nose studs will be issued a C4 and will therefore lose their social time until it is removed.
Make up	Make-up should be kept to an absolute minimum. If make-up is obvious then it is not acceptable
False Eyelashes	Whilst we do not endorse the wearing of false eyelashes, we understand that some students feel the need to wear them to support their self-esteem. However, if we deem that false eyelashes are disproportionally large, and/or curly, students will be issued with a C4 and will therefore lose their social time until they are removed.
Nails	Students are not permitted to wear nail extensions or any form of acrylic/other false nails that are attached to the students' natural nails. This includes nail jewellery which is attached to the students' natural nails. Nails should be natural in colour. Students who wear false nails or attachments to the nails as outline above will be issued a C4 and will therefore lose their social time until they are removed.
Tattoos	Tattoos are not permitted.
Fashion accessories	Students will be asked to remove any accessory which does not comply with our school uniform policy.
Hair	The school reserves the right to insist that what we consider to be extreme hairstyling and/or colouring be changed. Hair should look natural in colour and style. If in doubt, please contact a senior member of staff before making any changes.

Pre-loved Uniform

At the start of a new academic year and towards the end of the academic year we will ask all families if they have any school uniform that they no longer use and wish to donate.




Any pre-loved uniform can be donated to the main reception.

If any parents/carers require any pre-loved uniform, please contact the Year Leader to arrange collection of the garments. If you are able to, you may wish to make a small donation to our school uniform fund.

Optional Uniform

School jumpers and polo shirts can only be purchased from [Price and Buckland](#).





Grey tailored shorts can be purchased from Price and Buckland or from high street shops.

	<p>School Jumper (optional item) Grey school jumper with the All Saints badge. This is the only jumper that may be worn in school.</p> <p>Sweatshirts, hoodies and tracksuit tops cannot be worn and should not be brought into school.</p>
	<p>Pale Blue Polo Shirt (optional item) Polo shirts with the All Saints badge may be worn in the summer term only. No other polo shirts may be worn.</p>
	<p>Grey Tailored Shorts (optional item) Grey tailored shorts made of plain grey material and tailored in the style of school trousers may be worn in the summer term only. The colour should be mid grey to dark grey, not light.</p> <p>Sports shorts, denim shorts, chinos, shorts with logos/branding, cargo shorts, jogging style shorts or shorts made of stretchy material are not allowed.</p> <p>Shorts should be worn at the waist and not below.</p>

Compulsory PE Kit

Polo shirts and t-shirts can only be purchased from [Price and Buckland](#).

Navy blue PE shorts, leggings or tracksuit bottoms can be purchased from high street retailers.

<p>Sports Socks</p>	<p>Any socks are allowed as long as they are a change from their school socks.</p>	
<p>Indoor Trainers</p>	<p>Trainers should have non-marking soles and provide support to the ankle and foot.</p>	
<p>Outdoor Trainers</p>	<p>Trainers must be suitable for outdoor use and support the ankle and foot. Moulded plastic studs (for astro) and metal studs (for grass) are acceptable.</p>
